Junior/Parent Information Night & College Fair

Junior year brings many important decisions for juniors that will directly affect life after high school. Guidance counselors invite all 11th grade students and their parents to take part in an informative evening of workshops and presentations. Junior Information Night will take place on Wednesday, February 15. The evening begins with a college fair at 5:30PM. Admissions representatives from over 30 of Wisconsin's private colleges and the UW-System schools will be available for one hour prior to the workshop presentations. The workshop portion of the program will begin at 6:30 with a brief overview of guidance services, college application tasks and timelines. Following the brief introduction, students and parents will be able to attend up to three sectional workshops that will last approximately 20 minutes each. The evening will conclude at approximately 8:15 PM.

Sectional workshop topics will include: the University of Wisconsin System, the Wisconsin Private College System, the Wisconsin Technical College System, Scholarships and Financial Aid, ACT and SAT testing information and more.



West High School Captures Fifth Straight 'We the People' State Championship



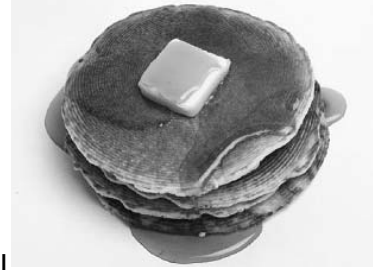
For the fifth consecutive year, West High School's We the People: The Citizen and the Constitution team has won the Wisconsin state championship. Competing against teams from across Wisconsin at Marquette University on Jan. 14, West High School won the right to represent Wisconsin at the national We the People competition in Virginia in April.

East High School's fourth-hour team placed second. Because there are several states not participating in Nationals this year, Wisconsin is able to send more than one team. Therefore, both West and East will be heading to Nationals on April 27-May1 at George Mason University in Virginia.

We the People is sponsored by the Center for Civic Education. The program is designed to spur broader understanding of politics and public affairs among high school students. The program is hosted in Wisconsin by the State Bar of Wisconsin Public Education Committee and the Wisconsin Law Foundation.

IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT FREE AND REDUCED MEALS

If your family has been severely impacted by the economic downturn, this information is extremely important for you and your children. No child should ever go hungry or skip lunch due to financial hardships at home. For the children that qualify, they will receive a main entrée, choices from the offering bar, and a milk for free or a reduced price of \$.40 per day. This is the same meal all children are offered whether they pay full price, reduced price or are free.

If your family is experiencing financial difficulties we strongly urge you to fill out an application for free or reduced meals. The process is confidential and easy. UW-System Placement Testing

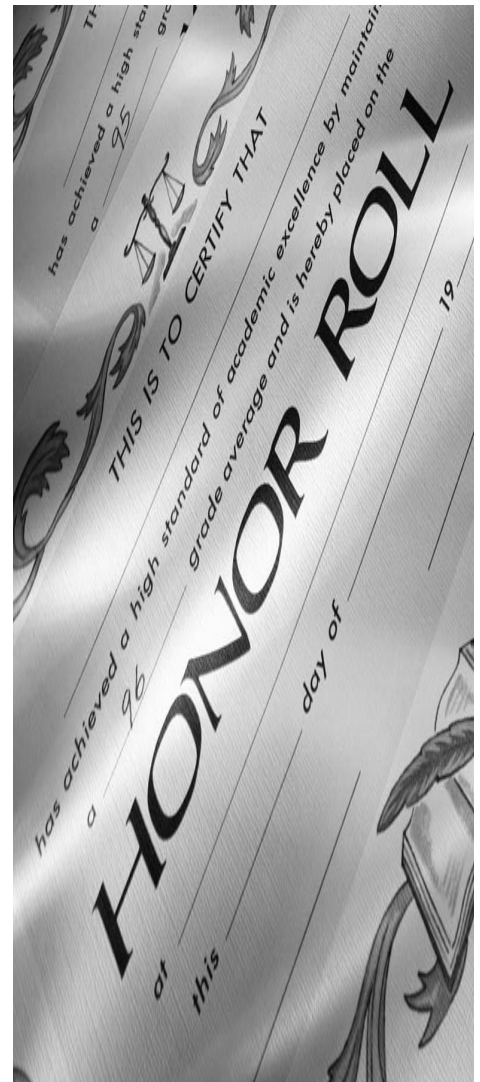
