Freshman Chiara White placed 22nd with a PR time of 21:37 (19th all-time). The JV raiders were paced by senior Sasha Roeder (22nd / 23:58), juniors Delaney Regan (27th 24:22) and Abby Buettner, and sophomores Molly Sumiec (33rd / 24:56) and Ava Brittingham (47th/ 25:25).
