Dr. William Schowalter is a renowned authority in the field of fluid mechanics. He is the author of “Mechanics of Non-Newtonian Fluids” and co-author of “Colloidal Dispersions.” Dr. Schowalter’s impressive academic career includes 31 years at Princeton University where he served as Chairman of the Department of Chemical Engineering and Associate Dean of the School of Engineering and Applied Science as well as the Class of 1950 Professor in Engineering and Applied Science. He went on to the positions of Dean and Professor of Chemical and Biomolecular Engineering at The University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign and Senior Advisor to the President of the National University of Singapore. He has served on advisory boards for the University of Michigan, University of California at Berkeley, and Stanford University as well as holding various positions in the NAE and NAS. Dr. Schowalter earned a BS in Chemical Engineering at the University of Wisconsin-Madison and went on to receive both an MS and PhD in the same field at UICU.
