

# Wauwatosa West High School Parking Regulations for 2019 – 2020

All students are required to have a parking permit to park in the Wauwatosa West High School parking lot. Students who park illegally or do not have a parking permit may be ticketed by the Wauwatosa Police Department. **Students who park in the school parking lot need to have a parking permit and parking sticker on their registered vehicle's front window, lower left corner by Tuesday, October 1st.**

## Sign Up

1. Senior parking permit sign-up will be from **September 9<sup>th</sup> - September 13<sup>th</sup>**.
2. Junior parking permit sign-up will be from **September 16<sup>th</sup> - September 20<sup>th</sup>**.
3. Sophomore parking permit sign-up will be from **September 23<sup>rd</sup> - September 27<sup>th</sup>**.

\* If you miss your designated sign-up dates, open enrollment will begin on **September 30<sup>th</sup>** and parking permits will be available until all permits have been purchased. Students may sign-up in the Activities Office before or after school.

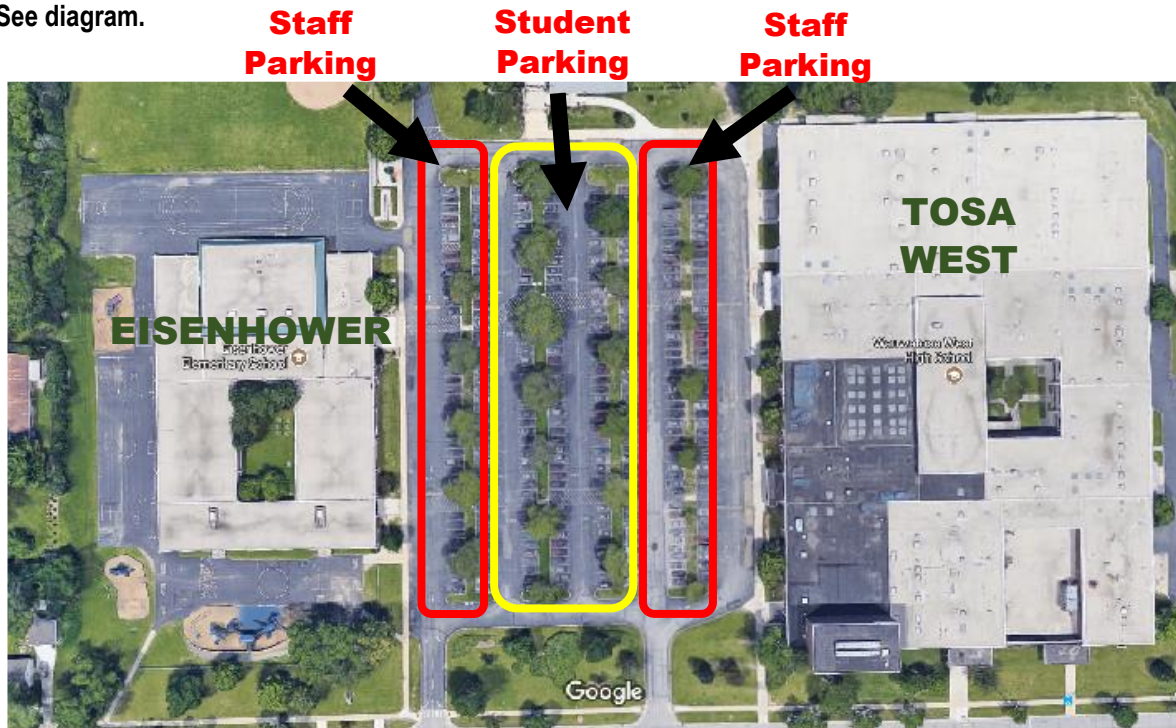
## Cost

Full Year Permits = \$20  
Semester Permits = \$10

*Replacement or 2<sup>nd</sup> parking stickers available for \$10*

## Parking Regulations

1. **Students must park your vehicle in the student designated parking areas – 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> rows of parking spaces. See diagram.**



2. Parking sticker/clings **MUST BE DISPLAYED on the interior, driver's side front window, lower left corner of the registered vehicle**. Motorcycle stickers are to be displayed on the rear fender.
3. Students will need a parking permit Monday through Friday during school hours (8 am – 4 pm). Vehicles parked in the Tosa West parking lot without a parking permit may receive a \$30 citation from the Wauwatosa Police Department.
4. Students using a temporary vehicle **MUST** sign in at the Welcome Desk at the southwest entrance. If a student will be using a temporary vehicle for more than 3 consecutive school days, they must see their associate principal for permission.
5. Students who fail to comply with these stated regulations will forfeit their parking privileges. Causes for suspension or permanent loss of parking permits may include, but are not limited to the following:
  - Falsification of any portion of the parking application
  - Leaving campus without permission
  - Failure to display parking sticker on vehicle

- Sharing of a parking sticker
- Failure to comply with safe driving rules & regulations on campus and on adjacent streets
- Parking illegally or parking in NO PARKING zones on Wauwatosa West's school property
- Driving on Wauwatosa West's school sidewalks or lawns
- Parking in Staff or Visitor parking spots
- Accumulation of 10 or more un-served detentions
- Suspension(s) from school
- Accumulation of 5 or more tardies (excused or unexcused) to 1<sup>st</sup> hour class or 5 unexcused absences

7. School officials, including our School Resource Officer may search any vehicle owned or operated by a student on school grounds at any time without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant if they have a reasonable suspicion that there is evidence of a crime or infraction of a school rule or contraband in the vehicle.

**Please Note:**

- **Students drive and park at their own risk. The school or district is NOT responsible for any damages, thefts or vandalism to vehicles.**
- **Parking on campus is a PRIVILEGE not a Right. Please abide by the stated parking rules and regulations to avoid loss of parking privileges.**
