



2019-2020 Disclosure of Student Information Notification

There are times the district may take photos or video of students to share positive news, via various methods, about student achievement and work we are doing in the district. This can at times include a story with print or TV news media.

If you do not want your child to be photographed or video recorded, you must indicate your request in writing to your school principal within 14 days of enrollment.

Request to Withhold Directory Data: WI Statute 118.125 requires the District to release the following directory data upon request to anyone who requests it: student's name, address, phone, place and date of birth, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, dates of attendance and photographs. State law allows parents/guardians the ability to request that your child's information be withheld from any of the following:

- Advertisers
- Military
- School/District Publications (i.e. sport/event programs, newsletters, website, yearbook, social media)
- Media (publication in media including news stories or photos, honor roll announcements, news coverage of events)

If you would like to withhold your child's information from any of these, please make sure to notify your school principal in writing. Such notification should include the student's name, age, address, school and grade level, as well as the parent or guardian's name, address and phone.

Notification must be given annually.
