Grab and Go Meals - Extended!

From the date physical school buildings closed in March, the Wauwatosa School District has provided more than 48,000 meals to students and families. Now, the District has approval from the Department of Public Instruction to extend our meal program to serve non-District community members who may also benefit from this free service. Athletic Department Facility Usage Guidelines

Our District's indoor and outdoor facilities are currently open, and athletic activities will be held at various District properties. Eviction Prevention

Milwaukee County is making available \$10 million in federal CARES Act funding to the Milwaukee County Housing Division to help prevent evictions, provide mortgage assistance and more.
