#### All Elementary Schools

#### Longfellow

Families may pick up students' locker belongings on Wednesday, May 6 from 8 am - 6 pm. Staff will be stationed at the far northeast door (Ms. Mohacsi's room). Items will be brought to you, and you will not need to exit your vehicle. If a student needs items from their Phy Ed locker, please email the student's Phy Ed teacher as soon as possible to ensure those items are included. If a student still has a heart rate monitor band for Phy Ed, please drop it off on May 6.

#### Whitman

Students' items may be picked up on Wednesday, May 6 between 8 am - 6 pm. Families of 6th and 7th grade students are encouraged to pick up items before 4 pm. Families of 8th grade students are encouraged to pick up between 4 - 6 pm.
