### **School Board Approves Request for Emergency Relief Funds**

This week, the [Wauwatosa School Board unanimously approved a legislative resolution](#) urging leaders to approve emergency relief funding to stabilize public schools. We are excited to announce that several outdoor field locations will be available for use under certain provisions beginning Monday, May 11. **Please note that individuals must make a reservation 24 hours in advance to access these outdoor spaces.** Reservations are open to Wauwatosa residents and Wauwatosa School District Students. To reserve a field and time slot, you must complete a [Field Usage Reservation Form](#).

Tennis courts at Longfellow Middle School and West High School will also be open. These spaces will not require a reservation. It is the responsibility of all participants to follow current safety rules including social distancing. If the guidelines are not followed, fields, ball diamonds and tennis courts may be closed to the public.
