District COVID-19 Protocols + Exposure Letters

Our District buildings are currently open, and summer programming - including the Recreation Department's Summer Adventure Club and Right at School Summer Camp - will be held at various District buildings. All individuals who wish to enter a District building must comply with our [Visitor Guidelines](#) which includes wearing a mask and completing a form prior to entry.

In the event an individual who has entered a District building contracts COVID-19, the data collected via this form will allow us to identify and notify individuals who may have been exposed. Within 24 hours of receiving confirmation of a positive COVID-19 case, the District will send letters to individuals who have been identified as:

LOW RISK: those who were in the same District building on the same date as the COVID-19-positive individual. [Click here to view a sample LOW RISK letter.](#)

MEDIUM RISK: those who have come within 6 feet of a COVID-19-positive individual for more than 10 minutes. [Click here to view a sample MEDIUM RISK letter.](#)

Individuals identified as **HIGH RISK** will be called via phone by the Wauwatosa Health Department.
