



Good evening,

Due to the Safer at Home order there are guidelines that we must all follow to do our part in slowing the spread of the COVID-19 virus. That would involve not congregating at City, County and School District playgrounds as they are all closed.

Parks remain open. When you go to a park, we advise that you think of it as “moving THROUGH the park” and not staying in, congregating in, or playing in the park. Same is true for other outdoor spaces.

Groups, team, or contact sports are not allowed. Hart Park Stadium, tennis courts, track, volleyball courts, baseball facilities, skatepark, and the Rotary Stage are not available.

This includes all School District properties, like East and Whitman Soccer Fields, West Football Complex, Breitlow Baseball Complex and other outdoor fields.

The past couple of days have been very problematic for the Wauwatosa Police Department in enforcing these rules. All the calls for enforcement of the Safer at Home regulations keeps them from doing the work we need them to do.
