



Enrolling in the Wauwatosa School District - Non-Residents -

Open Enrollment

- **On-line registration is available.**
- **Legislative priority for admittance** to the Open Enrollment program is given to:
 - Students currently attending the school district who move out of the district;
- AND
 - Siblings of current students in the district.
- A lottery process, held in Spring, is used to fill available open seats.
- Parents are responsible for providing transportation to and from school.
- The Open Enrollment application period begins the first Monday in February, in accordance with state law and runs through April.
- Future application periods:
 - 2017-2018: February 6—April 28, 2017
 - 2018-2019: February 5—April 30, 2018
 - 2019-2020: February 4—April 30, 2019
 - 2020-2021: February 3—April 30, 2020

Chapter 220

Since the 2010-2011 school year, the Wauwatosa School District is no longer able to accept new participants nor allow transfers out of the school district through the Chapter 220 program. Students who were in the program as of the 2010-2011 school year, are allowed to continue through graduation from the Wauwatosa School District.

Open Enrollment

Since Fall 1998, parents in Wisconsin have had the option of enrolling their child(ren) in any Wisconsin public school system with available space. As of the 2016-17 school year, 1,280 students were attending Wauwatosa public schools through the Open Enrollment program.

Chapter 220

The Chapter 220 integration program is designed to increase the enrollment of minority children in suburban school districts. Wauwatosa was one of the first school districts to participate in Chapter 220, dating back to 1976. The Chapter 220 application period opens every January. Transportation is provided to students coming in from Milwaukee by the Milwaukee Public School system.
